COURSE DESCRIPTIONS - 6th Grade

Art 1 (0.5)

This class provides an overview of visual arts while studying a variety of art tools and materials.

Band 1 – Brass (1.0)

This beginning band class focuses on the trumpet, horn, trombone, or tuba. Practice and concerts outside of class time and instrument are required. Instrument required (\$).

Band 1 – Percussion (1.0)

This beginning band class is offered for students who wish to learn mallet percussion instruments such as xylophone and marimba, as well as snare drum and other percussion instruments. Practice and concerts outside of class time are required. Percussion kit required (\$).

Band 1 – Woodwinds (1.0)

This beginning band class focuses on the flute, oboe, or clarinet. Practice and concerts outside of class time are required. Saxophone must start with the clarinet. Instrument required (\$).

Choir 1 (beginning, semester) (0.5)

This semester course emphasizes quality vocal production, part-singing, and music reading skills. Rehearsals and performances outside of class time are part of the course requirement and will constitute a portion of the grade.

Choir 1 (beginning, full year) (1.0)

See above, full year class.

Concert Band (1.0)

Prerequisite: Band 1 or Audition/Interview

This intermediate-level band course increases musical proficiency through performance and study of music. Practice, rehearsals, and concerts outside of class time are required. Instrument required (\$).

Dance 1 (0.5)

This course offers instruction on the fundamentals of dance techniques and composition. *(This class can satisfy the PE requirement, or it can be taken as an elective in addition to the traditional PE class.)*

Digital Literacy 6 (0.5)

Canyons School District now defines this course to be a 6th grade requirement, and CCA (College and Career Awareness) will be moved to 8th grade in the 28-29 school year.

This course allows students to develop basic computing fundamentals, improve digital communications, identify the importance of protecting individual data, apply key applications, and maintain positive digital wellness. Students will have opportunities to use digital devices to apply skills to accomplish tasks more efficiently using creativity, critical thinking, productivity, and collaboration in the classroom and day-to-day life.

FCS 6 (0.5)

This semester class introduces all areas of Family & Consumer Sciences (FCS). Students explore basics in Personal Skills (communication, organization, and handling stress), Childcare (preschool and first aid), Sewing (cooling neck wrap and pillowcase), Foods and Nutrition (salsa, soft pretzels, etc.), Interior Design (online designs), and Free Enterprise (shark tank business competition).

Guitar 1 (0.5)

This course introduces learning to play a guitar. Emphasis will be placed on reading music, fundamental technique in the first position, simultaneous singing and playing, and tone production. Practice outside of class time and instrument required (\$).

Intro to French Language and Culture (0.5)

This semester class introduces the French language and vocabulary for people and things in everyday life through games, songs, and practice. Students also learn about the countries where French is spoken.

Intro to Spanish Language and Culture (0.5)

In this semester course, students will learn about basic Spanish words and phrases. Students will also learn about Spanish culture and a global community of the Spanish-speaking world.

Intro to Speech and Debate (0.5)

This semester course is designed to introduce students to debate, analysis, reasoning, delivery skills, organization, writing techniques and research. The course provides opportunities for impromptu speaking, original oratory, extemporaneous speaking.

Orchestra 1 (1.0)

This beginner class focuses on the violin, viola, cello, or string bass. Practice and concerts outside of class time and instrument required (\$).

Orchestra 2 (1.0)

Prerequisite: Instructor approval

This is an intermediate-level class. Practice, rehearsals, and performances outside of class time are required. Instrument required (\$).

PE 6 (Team Sports) (0.5)

This course is designed to teach sports that involve and require group participation and cooperation. *(This class satisfies the PE requirement.)*

STEM Concepts (0.5)

A course that aids students in developing the ability to apply understanding of how the world works within and across the areas of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM), promoting abilities to better problem-solve, analyze, communicate, and understand technology.
